

Humanitarian Centre membership 2011-12

Organisational membership

The cost of membership is nominal, and based on organisational turnover as follows:

Membership Band	Organisational turnover	Membership fee 2011-12
A	£0-10k	£10
B	£10 – 100k	£40
C	£100 – 250k	£90
D	£250k +	£180

Please note: if an organisation joins after 1st February the membership fee for the first year will be halved.

Criteria for becoming a member

- Based within the local area of Cambridge
- Registered with, and accountable to, one of the following; the Charity Commission, Companies House, Anglia Ruskin University or the University of Cambridge
- An organisation that works to alleviate global poverty/inequality or raise awareness of global poverty/inequality

Benefits of organisational membership

Organisational members of the Humanitarian Centre will be entitled to:

- Apply to trustees for regular use of desk space/hotdesks within the building (subject to availability)
- Use the meeting room and office resources free of charge or at member rates
- Attend Humanitarian Centre networking meetings, events and training at member rates
- Attend the Humanitarian Centre AGM, and vote for trustees
- Nominate a member representative to advise the Humanitarian Centre board
- Have a link on the Humanitarian Centre website, and have their organisational logo displayed on Humanitarian Centre materials
- Receive regular updates on Humanitarian Centre activities and services
- Make suggestions to trustees and to the Director of the Humanitarian Centre for further services and activities which support the achievement of organisational goals

Non-members of the Humanitarian Centre will be entitled to:

- Receive regular updates on HC activities and services
- Attend Humanitarian Centre networking meetings, events and training at non-member rates and with secondary priority.

Notes on organisational membership

- Organisational membership is decided at quarterly trustee meetings: organisations wishing to become members should download the template letter to trustees from the membership page of the Humanitarian Centre website.
- Organisations have voting rights under the Humanitarian Centre constitution, and are liable for up to £1 should the Humanitarian Centre be wound up.
- The membership year runs from August to July. If an organisation joins after 1st February the membership fee for the first year will be halved.
